NURS FPX 4015 Assessment 4: Applying Ethical and Leadership Principles

NURS FPX 4015 Assessment 4 focuses on ethical leadership and decision-making in nursing practice. Students are expected to analyze a healthcare issue, apply ethical frameworks, and propose solutions that promote patient safety and quality outcomes.

Key elements of this assessment include:

- Identification of ethical challenges in healthcare settings
 - Application of leadership and ethical decision-making models
 - Use of evidence-based nursing literature
 - Clear and logical academic writing with APA formatting
- Strong performance in this assessment demonstrates a nurse's readiness to lead ethically in complex clinical environments.

NURS FPX 4045 Assessment 1: Foundations of Quality and Safety

NURS FPX 4045 Assessment 1 introduces students to quality improvement and patient safety concepts. The assessment typically requires identifying a quality or safety concern and analyzing its impact on patient outcomes and healthcare systems.

Students must demonstrate:

- Understanding of quality and safety standards in nursing
- Analysis of system-level factors affecting patient care
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
